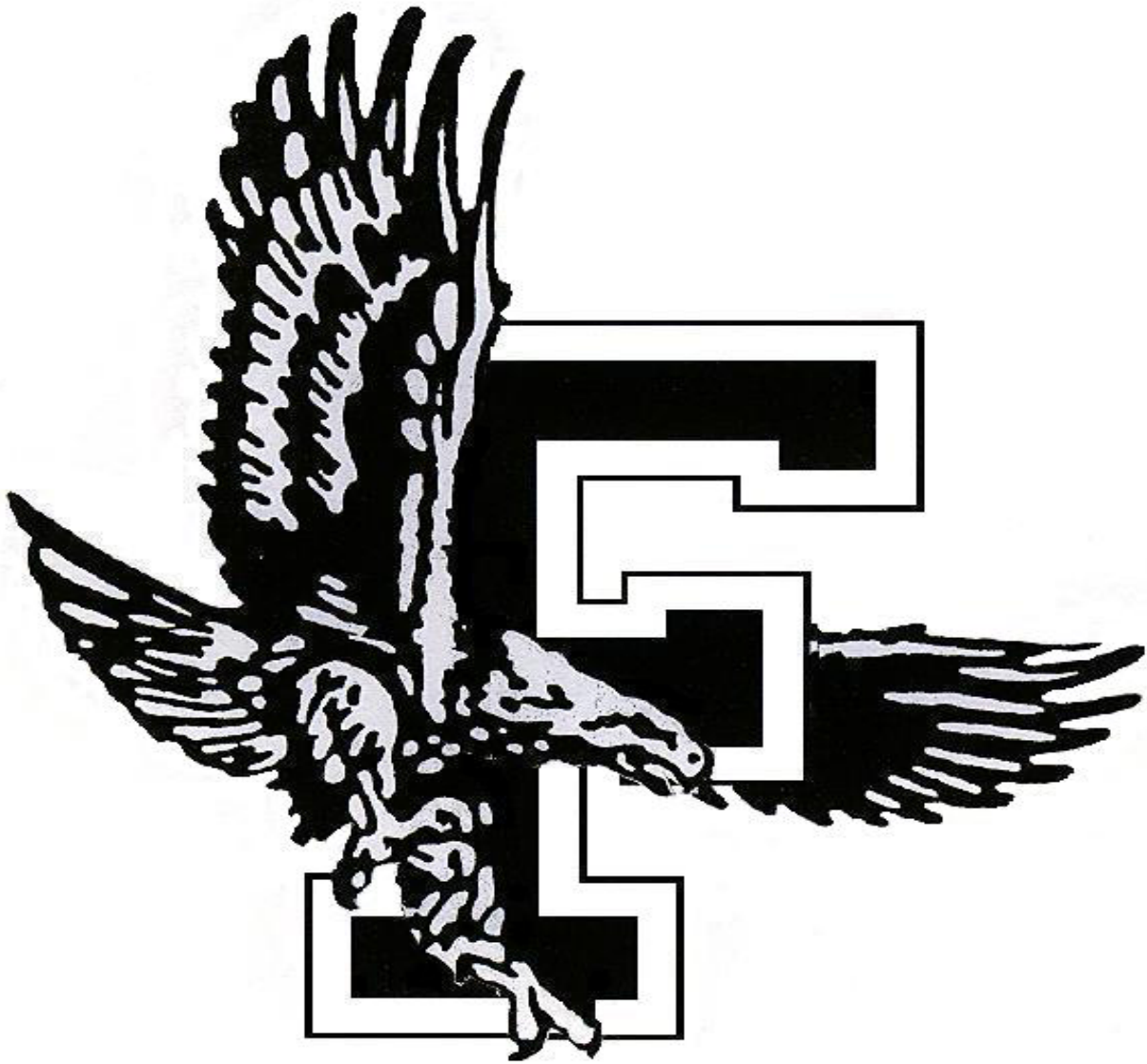

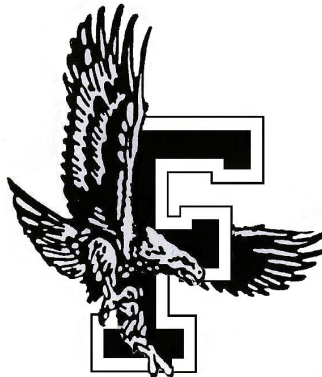

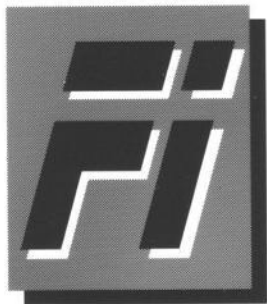

SALONS SCAMMED

BREKON — A woman suspected of using her pregnancy last fall to steal credit cards from customers at area beauty parlors was arrested over the weekend in New Hampshire, police said.

Wendy Jane Carlin, 29, of 6367 Cranford Ave., North Fort, Fla., faces 12 fraud-related charges from Marlborough, Worcester and Westborough district courts.

Carlin's arrest was predicated on her pregnancy, police say. She would go to salons and discuss with stylists the harmful effects of different hair products on her unborn baby, said Hudson Police Capt. David Saperstein. After talking about the products, Carlin would ask to use the bathroom, snatching purses on the way and rifling through the wallet in the meantime looking for credit cards, he said.

Police did not say whether Carlin has given birth since the thefts.

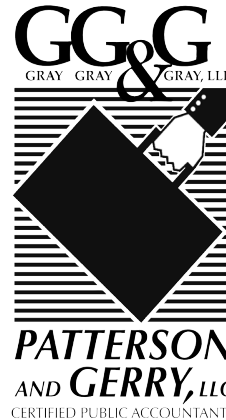

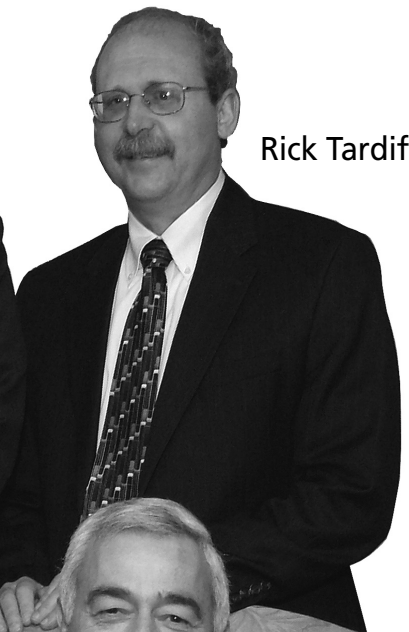

Roni Cronin is Framingham through and through. She attended Framingham public schools for 12 years, graduating with the Class of 1959, and enjoyed a remarkable 37-year teaching career at the Juniper Hill School. Now, she is a dedicated volunteer at the Framingham Historical Society & Museum, a role that seems to be perfect in that it combines her love of history, Framingham and teaching. The Framingham Historical Society & Museum is a vital part of town. Since 1975, it has collaborated with the Framingham public school system on a "History of Framingham" program for third-grade students. The program is not lecture-based, but instead designed to help students experience their hometown, and understand Framingham's history as part of American history. Through her passion for teaching, history and Framingham, Roni is an integral part of the effort.

When Lowell Mazie started the John Andrew Mazie Memorial Foundation in 1997, along with his wife Barbara and daughter Linda, the hope was to carry on his son's legacy by helping to positively impact the lives of students. The results have been remarkable. Since the foundation was founded, more than 270 sophomores at Framingham High have been matched with volunteer mentors from Framingham and surrounding communities as part of a program that would make John proud. John, who worked at APM in Framingham, had always expressed concern about the plight of underprivileged youngsters. Through the foundation and the continued efforts of Lowell and his family, more than 100 students at Framingham High have received laptop computers as an award for achieving their college research goals, and 53 are now in college receiving their annual \$500 scholarship awards. Each year, 40 new students are accepted into the program.



Pat Walker

Pat Walker has been a valuable employee at the Danforth Museum of Art for the last 29 years, earning a well deserved reputation for going above and beyond her regular responsibilities. That additional work is a significant part of her being an honoree, as the Salute to Framingham committee will annually be seeking one honoree that it feels reflects the always-doing-more approach of longtime Framingham High School teacher and Salute committee member Rich Rebecchi. When Pat started at the Danforth Museum of Art, teaching a painting class, she couldn't have envisioned how fulfilling her tenure would become. From seeing youngsters learning about art for the first time in the museum's children's gallery, to 700 Framingham Public School third graders exploring the museum's Native American collection, to high school students in Portfolio classes, Pat appreciates the efforts of those who make Danforth Museum of Art a special place in which the importance of art is reflected in the town of Framingham.

SUE AMES has been one of the driving forces – a true advocate – for the health and physical education department at Framingham High School for fifteen years. She does not let the department rest on its laurels and is a true believer in continuous improvement. This approach has been instrumental in developing and sustaining a quality health education program that is a highlight of the Commonwealth. Sue regularly scans the literature looking for the latest health and PE research to distribute to students and staff, resulting in a curriculum that is up-to-date, vigorous, and informative. Sue Ames believes her role, the seminal role, of an educator is to teach the importance of respect, responsibility, and being a self-advocate. Her actions are a clear validation of this belief as evident in her passionate teaching style and her willingness to do “what needs to get done” to complete a task. She is an active member of the district Health Advisory Council and the FHS Wellness Policy Council and also referees both field hockey and lacrosse at both the high school and college level. When an objective and sound shoulder is needed, Sue is available to listen and help students and colleagues organize their thoughts to make a reasonable decision. LINDA BEBEAU - Working at Dunning School since 1984, Mrs. Bebeau has dedicated herself to the development of excited, skillful learners. Mrs. Bebeau has supported first grade students as they confront the many learning challenges but especially the daunting task of unlocking the literacy code. Her enthusiasm and talent provide a classroom that welcomes every student and brings outstanding results. Mrs. Bebeau’s warmth for and investment in her students is completely genuine. Families are informed and their children rewarded under the care of Mrs. Bebeau. In addition, her knowledge and flair are a resource for the entire staff. Mrs. Bebeau provides guidance to whoever requires assistance but does so in such a professional and unassuming style. She acts as informal mentor to her first grade colleagues and combines the wisdom of experience and the energy of innovation.

Mrs. Bebeau is a fixture amongst the Dunning community plainly putting that extra effort in everything she does. She is a positive and motivating force not only for her learners but for all that encounter her. In the age of data and test scores, we have lost sight of the importance of relationship and connection within the learning dynamic but spend fifteen minutes in Mrs. Bebeau classroom and you quickly remember the critical importance of those qualities. ANNE BILOTTI accepted a permanent assistant teacher position at McCarthy Elementary School in 1994, and, since that time, she has distinguished herself as a dedicated, involved educator. Anne is always willing to assume extra tasks to support the social, emotional, physical, and academic growth of her students. She established an after school homework club and a very successful after school MCAS tutoring program. She even tutors children before school begins. Anne consistently acts on the belief that all students can learn. She played a critical role in developing an extremely effective inclusion program which has become a model for the school. Currently, she assists the regular educators and the special educator in planning and executing teaching units in fourth and fifth grade classrooms. In addition, she works with small groups of students and utilizes a variety of teaching strategies to engage them and to help them experience success. The positive and supportive relationship that she has established with her students serves to enhance their self-esteem and their ability to learn. WILL COOK has worked as an English teacher at Framingham High School for the past fifteen years. For the past five years, he has been the English Department Chairperson. Will is an excellent teacher and a strong department chair but his greatest gift may be his ability to have a positive influence on teaching and learning through the many roles he fills in the school as well as in town.

Will has upheld the high standards set by his predecessors Jack Donovan and Linda Shevrin in the English Department. He works extremely hard to recruit high quality faculty and to foster their growth in the department. Throughout the summer months, Will can be found volunteering his time in the English bookroom, meeting with new teachers or at his desk getting things organized so his staff can have a smooth opening in September. He challenges his own students and has displayed a passion to teach all students, regardless of their ability or learning desire. In the building, Will has been a volunteer building representative for the teacher's association and most recently served on the bargaining committee and fought for a fair contract. When some students discussed a desire to form a sailing club several years ago, Will and Bob Curnan rented vans and trekked students back and forth to the Charles River in Boston after school. During its six years the club never became a varsity sport but the Framingham students competed successfully against other Bay State varsity programs. His willingness to help students athletically continues as he most recently has volunteered his afternoons in the fall as the assistant golf coach. Seeing that educators were under-represented in town meeting, Will decided to run so that the voices of more teachers could be heard. He has served proudly for three terms and does a fine job speaking out for the schools in Framingham either in formal town meeting or by caucusing with other town meeting members. Will has helped improve the educational experience for students in Framingham in many different ways. He has a solid record of fighting for teachers, students and for the schools. WILL JANTZEN is being recognized because of his many exceptional qualities. This young man, a U.S. veteran of the Afghanistan conflict and trained EMT, possesses a level of maturity far beyond his years. As an aide for a student with special needs, he has used his sensitivity, patience and innate abilities to establish an extraordinary bond with this student who requires extensive assistance in many areas throughout the day. Will provides this support with consistency, while aiding both the teachers and other students in the classroom. His positive attitude and willingness to help out wherever needed, make him invaluable to Walsh. He works in both the Study Zone after school program as well as the LEAP club program. His experiences at Walsh have allowed him to see future possibilities for himself in the field of education. He is contemplating continuing his education and becoming a teacher.
